Serious condition is defined as cancer, HIV, AIDS, amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, Alzheimer's disease, rheumatoid arthritis, fibromyalgia, severe migraines, Parkinson's disease, multiple sclerosis, spinal cord damage, epilepsy, inflammatory bowel disease, neuropathies, Huntington's disease, or certain specified symptoms or complications associated with the conditions listed above. This act provides that the Department of Health and Senior Services must issue a registration card to a person who provides a certification signed by a practitioner that the person or minor suffers from a serious condition and may benefit from treatment with medical marijuana, indicates the practitioner is qualified to treat the condition, states that the individual is under the practitioner's continuing care, and provides the form of marijuana the patient should consume, including the method of consumption, any particular strain, variety, quantity or percentage and the appropriate dosage. The act indicates the records which should be maintained by practitioners. This act specifies that possession of or application for a registration card does not constitute probable cause to search the person or property of the person. This act requires the Department of Health and Senior Services to

maintain a confidential list of people with registration cards. The list is confidential except in certain specified circumstances. Registrants must possess a form of medical marijuana that complies with the practitioner's certification. A registrant may possess up to a 30-day supply of the medical marijuana dosage certified by the practitioner. During the last seven days of the 30-day period, the registrant may possess a 30-day supply for the following month as well. This act specifies certain provisions regarding seizure of medical marijuana, the liability of people being near the medical use of marijuana, and the rights of registrants with regard to routine traffic stops and employment. The act provides that the fraudulent misrepresentation to an officer of any fact relating to the use of products containing medical marijuana in order to avoid arrest is a class D misdemeanor. This act prohibits a licensed medical marijuana grower from obtaining marijuana from outside the state, employing felons, and selling medical marijuana without verifying the validity of the buyer's registration card. Growers must clearly label marijuana products.

The office is to be administered by a director and deputy director, who are to be appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate for a term of six years. This act specifies the information that the office has access to, the powers granted to the office, and the requirements of the office.

Current law defines a missing person as a person who is missing and who meets certain characteristics. Under this act, a missing person is any person who is missing regardless of whether they meet one of the enumerated characteristics, and a "high risk missing person" is a missing person who meets one of the specified characteristics. The list of characteristics is expanded.

In addition, current law allows a person to file a complaint of a missing person with a law enforcement agency that has jurisdiction. A list of information that must be included with the

complaint is provided. This act removes the requirement that the agency have jurisdiction and expands the information to be included with the complaint. The act also prohibits a law enforcement agency from refusing to accept a missing persons report for certain reasons.

This act specifies certain information that law enforcement agencies must provide to the person making a missing persons report, family members, or other persons who can assist in locating the missing person.

Under this act, local law enforcement agencies must make use of all available tools, resources, and technologies available to resolve a missing persons case. In addition, this act provides a list of information and materials a law enforcement agency must attempt to obtain if a person remains missing for more than thirty days.

This act requires that all DNA samples obtained in missing persons cases be immediately forwarded to an appropriate crime laboratory for analysis.

Under this act, law enforcement agencies must immediately determine whether a person who is reported missing is a "high risk missing person". The Missouri State Highway Patrol Missing Persons Unit must be contacted if the person is a high risk missing person. This act specifies further additional duties of law enforcement agencies and the Missing Persons Unit when a person is determined to be a high risk missing person.

This act expands the information regarding unidentified deceased persons that county coroners and medical examiners must obtain. In addition, this act requires county coroners and medical examiners to promptly enter information in national and state databases that can aid in the identification of missing persons.

Under this act, any person with custody of human remains that are not identified within 24 hours of discovery must promptly notify the Missouri State Highway Patrol of the location of those remains. An

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agency handling the remains of a missing person who is determined to be deceased must notify the law enforcement agency handling the missing person case. Documented efforts must be made to locate family members of the deceased person to inform them of the death and location of the remains of their family member.

## SB 1072 - Hegeman

Relating to reimbursement for emergency medical transportation services under the MO HealthNet program

Under this act, an eligible MO HealthNet provider may receive a supplemental reimbursement, in addition to the MO HealthNet reimbursement such provider would otherwise receive for ground emergency medical transportation services, provided that such reimbursement shall not exceed 100% of actual costs. The act specifies how such supplemental payment shall be calculated and how an eligible provider's claimed expenditures for the ground emergency medical transportation services shall be eligible for federal financial participation.

This act also requires the Department of Social Services to design and implement an intergovernmental transfer program relating to ground emergency medical transport services in order to increase capitation payments for the purpose of increasing reimbursement to eligible providers, managed care plans, and coordinated care organizations, as detailed in the act. Any eligible provider participating in this program shall agree to reimburse the Department for any costs associated with implementing the program.

All such provisions in this act are subject to federal approval, as necessary.
