This bill provides a tax credit to individuals who provides at least 10 hours per week of personal care services to someone who has a disability as determined by any applicable federal or state agency or department or someone who is age 65 or older. The tax credit will be equal to \$5,000 and begin with the 2025 tax year. A taxpayer is limited to one credit per year. An affidavit must be prepared and submitted as specified in the bill. The bill also provides a tax credit of \$5000 to the recipient of personal care services as long as they meet the criteria of having a disability as determined by an applicable agency or is at least age 65 or older. An affidavit must be signed and submitted. Procedures for assisting those who may not be able to sign the forms independently are outlined.

This bill requires that upon notification by a hospital that a child is being boarded, the juvenile court having jurisdiction over the child or the juvenile court in the same county as the hospital will immediately intervene or take custody of the child to ensure the child is placed in the appropriate setting and provided proper treatment. The bill also requires the Department of Mental health, upon notification by a hospital that an individual with a developmental disability, serious mental illness, or substance use disorder is being boarded, to provide case management and treatment without delay in the least restrictive environment possible. The treatment can include residential or inpatient as appropriate. Hospitals will be reimbursed for actual boarding costs or the full allowable costs under MO HealthNet rules for each day of boarding after notification.
