This bill allows local taxing entities to create property tax work-off programs for individuals who are at least 65 years old, the owner of a homestead, been and remains a resident of the taxing entity, and are on a low, fixed income including those types listed in the bill. These programs would allow individuals able to meet volunteer qualifications to perform temporary volunteer work for the taxing entity or for any entity receiving or using revenue generated from the property tax instead of paying the property tax. The maximum that can be earned through this program is \$1,000 or less. Calculation of hours and other specifics are in the bill.

This bill creates a tax credit for homestead property owners who are at least 65 years old or who have a disability and have income less than or equal to the maximum upper limit and have not made improvements to the homestead that are more than 2.5% of the assessed value unless done to accommodate an individual with a disability. Eligibility criteria for couples is included in the bill. Factors that would disqualify taxpayers are specified. One is claiming the property tax credit. It would begin January 1, 2025.
