The property tax credit set in this bill would apply to certain increases. All taxing entities that levy property taxes are included in this bill. The ordinance will be submitted to the voters. If enough voters are in favor the tax credit would be implemented. **Status:** 1/25/24 Introduced and First Read (H)

This would be proposed to voters for consideration.
