Only those parts related to people with disabilities are summarized.

This bill prohibits school districts from retaining attorneys or law firms who employ or contract with school district members or employees for providing counsel or litigating any administrative or legal proceeding regarding a student's individualized education program. It places the burden of proof and burden of production on school districts when a due process hearing of a student with a disability is involved. A student is required to remain in the present educational placement, eligibility status, and special education services while a proceeding is pending unless a different agreement is reached. The bill specifies when this can be invoked. The bill adds to the definition of special education record.
